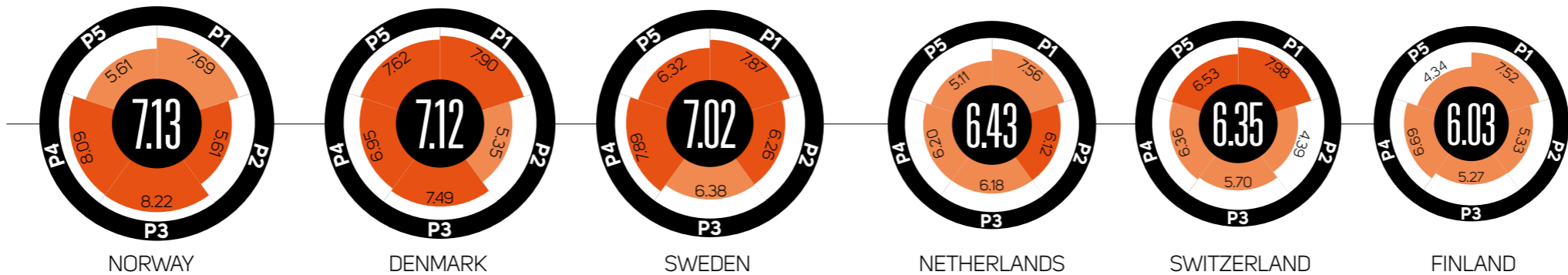


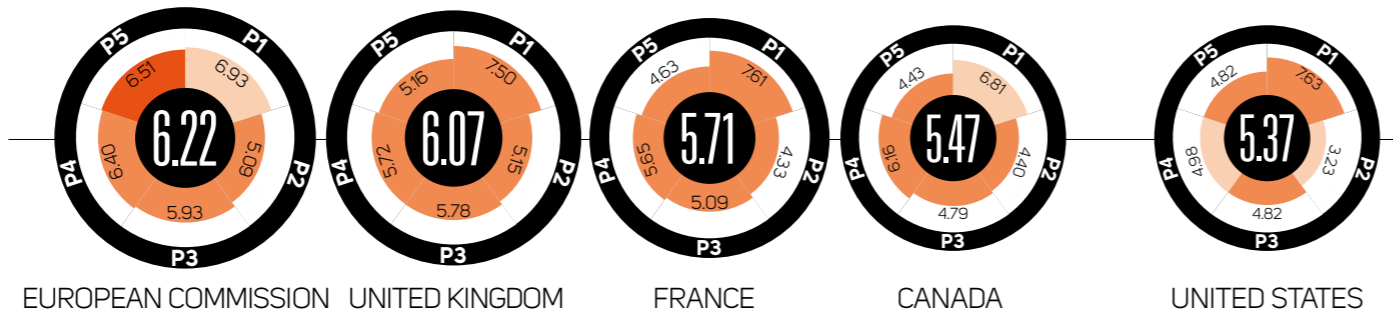
## Group 1 PRINCIPLED PARTNERS

Characterised by their generosity, strong commitment to humanitarian principles of neutrality, impartiality and independence, and flexible funding arrangements with partners

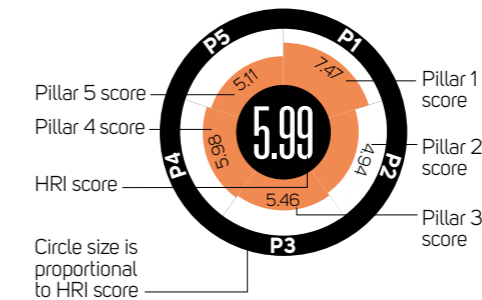


## Group 2 LEARNING LEADERS
